### Addendum to Assembly Instructions

---

The current instruction set was based on a final pre-production bike and there were some components that weren't quite finalized at that writing.

#### **Parts left over**

There may be a few parts left over in the small parts box when your assembly is complete. Specifically:

There are two spacers intended to replace the rack bosses that are between the seat post and the seat back mounts. If you choose to remove the built-in rack (for example, if you want to substitute a mountain bike post rack), they take up the space that's left if you remove the rack, so that the seat post works properly.

The short segments of cable housing insulators can be put anywhere you want if cable rubbing on the frame bothers you. They don't add much value when the cables are properly arranged through the pivot clamp at the base of the steering column.
